(May 26, 2005)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the response of witness Taufique to Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2, Question 15, issued April 22, 2005. This response is 20 days overdue because of the need to identify and verify changed volume and revenue figures, which resulted from a change in account reporting that was discovered close to the deadline for responding. Preparing an accurate response involved discussions among several postal employees, some who were not at Headquarters, and others who were not available until recently.
