**NOTICE OF BOOKSPAN WITHDRAWAL OF FILING OF REDIRECTED
RESPONSE OF WITNESS POSCH TO INTERROGATORY OF THE
NEWSPAPER ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA (NAA/USPS-T1-1)**

On August 30, 2005, Bookspan filed a redirected response of Witness Posch to the Interrogatory of the Newspaper Association of America (NAA/USPS-T1-1). Due to a typographical error, that response was mislabeled in the descriptive cover page of that filing, and as a result, is identified on the Commission's website index as "NNA/USPS-T1-14".

The Postal Service had redirected the question to Bookspan, but subsequently filed a response to the question on August 25, 2005. With the concurrence of Postal Service counsel, Bookspan is withdrawing its response because the question was originally directed to the Postal Service, and its response has been filed.
