UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF REPLY
IN OPPOSITION TO DAVID POPKIN MOTION TO COMPEL A RESPONSE TO
INTERROGATORY DBP/USPS-30
(March 16, 2006)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance today of the filing of its opposition to the March 7, 2006 motion to compel of David Popkin, insofar as that motion pertains to interrogatory DBP/USPS-30. A timely opposition to those portions of Mr. Popkin's March 7th motion to compel responses to interrogatories DBP/USPS-3, 6, 18 and 19 was filed on March 14th. The press of business and the unavailability of personnel who needed to be consulted with regard to DBP/USPS-30 prevented Postal Service counsel from filing an opposition to the final portion of Mr. Popkin's motion on that date. The Postal Service regrets the two-day delay but considers that no party has been prejudiced by it.
