- c. Explain specifically what steps a non-PRS Parcel Select mailer must perform in order to use no-fee Delivery Confirmation.

RESPONSE:

- c. There are basically three key steps for a Parcel Select shipper to receive no-fee Delivery Confirmation. The shipper must create and submit an electronic manifest file to Product Tracking System; produce Delivery Confirmation labels which require precertification by NCSC prior to distribution; and establish appointments at each destination entry facility. The detailed steps for electronic manifest and label requirements are outlined in USPS Publication 91.
