PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING ADJUSTING  
THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(Issued September 6, 2006)

Presiding Officer's Ruling No. N2006-1/30 established the schedule for the remaining procedural dates in this case. Hearings to receive rebuttal to the cases-in-chief of participants were set for October 19 – 20, 2006. A conflict now exists with those dates. As a result, I am adjusting the procedural schedule.

Evidence in rebuttal to cases-in-chief of participants is now to be filed on October 11, 2006, two days in advance of the previously-established filing date of October 13, 2006.

Hearings to receive evidence in rebuttal to cases-in-chief of participants are rescheduled also to begin two days earlier, on October 17, 2006. If necessary, these hearings will continue on October 18, 2006.
