PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING ON MOTION
CONCERNING INTERROGATORY DBP/USPS-100

(Issued September 6, 2006)

A David B. Popkin Motion to Compel Response to Interrogatory DBP/USPS-100 and Motion to Require the Postal Service to File Motions for Late Acceptance of Interrogatory Responses (Motion) was filed September 5, 2006. The motion is denied.

Interrogatory DBP/USPS-100 seeks clarification of answers to a line of discovery initiated on February 15, 2006 with interrogatory DBP/USPS-14. The motion sets forth the development of the record on this point. It is evident from review of this history that the record for Commission evaluation of the Postal Service request in this docket will not be improved by further pleadings and responses on this issue.

RULING
