NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
OF FILING ADDITIONAL MATERIALS REQUESTED AT THE TECHNICAL  
CONFERENCE ON THE PERIODICALS MODEL  
(January 18, 2008)

At the January 11, 2008 technical conference on the Periodicals flats cost model included within USPS-FY07-11 (as part of the FY 2007 Annual Compliance Report filed on December 28, 2007), the Postal Service agreed to provide some additional materials. These materials are intended to assist parties in their understanding of the consequences of some of the modeling decisions made during the preparation of USPS-FY07-11. Attached electronically to this filing are two files, described below.

**R2006-1 inputs PER for PRC – hybrid 010608.xls**: Hybrid model using data and inputs from PRC-LR-14 and TW-LR-L-2 from Docket No. R2006-1, while using the methodology and changes from FY2007 ACR.

**R2006-1 PER for PRC-R2006 replication.xls**: Replication model as requested at the technical conference. This model uses R2006-1 inputs, but reverses the methodological changes and corrections applied in the FY 2007 ACR model to the maximum extent reasonably feasible, to show the basic functional equivalence between the R2006-1 PRC model and the unadjusted FY 2007 ACR model.

One avenue to pursue any questions about these materials would be at the further technical conference on these matters, scheduled for January 23, 2008. Additionally, some summary information about differences between these models and the USPS-FY07-11 model can be found in the supplemental materials filed today as revisions to USPS-FY07-11.
