

NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF FILING OF ERRATA TO
TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS OF WITNESS SECKAR (USPS-T-2)
AND TO EXHIBITS OF WITNESS PLUNKETT (USPS-T-5)
(August 10, 1998)

The United States Postal Service hereby provides notice that it is today filing errata to the testimony and Exhibit A of witness Seckar (USPS-T-2), and to Exhibits A and B of witness Plunkett (USPS-T-5). Corrected electronic versions of witness Seckar's Exhibit A (library reference 4) and witness Plunkett's Exhibits A through E (library reference 8) are also being filed today. The revisions to witness Seckar's testimony corrects the impression costs presented in Table 1, in order to reflect changes in maintenance cost calculations presented in the revision to Exhibit A, Tables 1 and 12. These changes increase impression costs on average by about 10 percent. Corrected testimony and exhibit pages are attached.

Witness Plunkett's Exhibits A and B are revised in order to reflect the revised maintenance costs, as well as to correct some calculation errors and inadvertent usage of an outdated version of input data from witness Seckar. The changes are described in the attachment. These corrections do not affect witness Plunkett's proposals or testimony at all, but increase his estimates of Mailing Online revenues for the experiment by about 5 percent. Corrected pages, along with additional documentation (replacing the notes in the original exhibits), are being provided today as attachments to witness Plunkett's responses to interrogatories OCA/USPS T-5




and 21. Electronic copies of the revised exhibits are provided in library reference 8, filed today.


