**CONSENT MOTION OF CAPITAL ONE SERVICES, INC. FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE MOTIONS TO COMPEL
RESPONSES TO INTERROGATORIES COS/USPS 27-44**

(March 27, 2009)

Capital One Financial Services, Inc. (Capital One) respectfully requests an extension of time to file motions to compel responses to its Interrogatories COS/USPS 27-44, which were filed on March 6, 2009. The Postal Service objected to Interrogatories COS/USPS-30(B-C), 40, and 41(C) on March 16, and filed responses to Interrogatories COS/USPS-27, 30-37, 39-41, and 44 on March 20, 2009. Under Rule 26 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, motions to compel would be due on March 30, 2009 (objections), and April 3, 2009 (incomplete responses). Capital One requests an extension until April 17, 2009, to file motions to compel.

Capital One is discussing the objections and responses with the Postal Service and has identified areas which might be resolved between the parties without litigation before the Commission, including the Postal Service's objections relating to "commercial sensitivity." Counsel for the Postal Service was unavailable this week due to illness and Capital One intends to pursue these discussions next week. The Postal Service has consented to this Motion.

Capital One accordingly requests an extension of time for filing its Motions to Compel until April 17, 2009.
