PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
GRANTING MOTIONS FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE
REGARDING RESPONSE TO
PRESIDING OFFICER'S INFORMATION REQUEST

(Issued June 30, 2005)

Motions for late acceptance to Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 7 were filed on June 28, 2005. The responses were two days late due to issues raised in a Postal Service motion concerning file replacement CD-ROMs for library references. The delay does not appear unreasonable under the circumstances and there appears to be no prejudice to any participant from granting these requests.

RULING
