Pursuant to Rule 191(b), identification of Bookspan as the party to the agreement underlying the Postal Service's Request serves as the Notice of Intervention for BOOKSPAN in this proceeding. The same rule dictates that BOOKSPAN shall be considered a co-proponent of this NSA.

Finally, pursuant to Rule 192(b), Bookspan concurrently files the testimonies of Robert Posch (BOOKSPAN-T-1) and Matthias Epp (BOOKSPAN-T-2) in support of its NSA and of the Postal Service's filing. As required by this rule, the Postal Service has stated in its Testimony that it has reviewed Mr. Posch's and Mr. Epp's testimonies and has affirmed that they may be relied upon in the presentation of the Postal Service's direct case.
