UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the filing of its responses to the above listed questions in Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2. The responses were due to have been filed yesterday. Consultations necessary for the preparation of certain responses continued late into the afternoon yesterday, leaving little time for the assembly of all complete responses before the filing deadline. An intermittent (still unresolved) disappearance of undersigned counsel's access to the Law Department's PDF function required a computer shutdown and re-boot yesterday that prevented a timely filing of the responses that were ready for filing.
