NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE REGARDING THE  
STATUS OF OUTSTANDING DISCOVERY RESPONSES  
(May 25, 2006)

As directed by Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 1/12, the United States Postal Service hereby submits a status report on the documents and plans referred to in the Motion of the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO, to Extend Discovery, filed on May 17, 2006, and on outstanding discovery. Responses to the following interrogatories will be filed on or before June 5, 2006: POIR 2 (Questions 6 and 14), APWU/USPS-T1-9, APWU-T1-22-26, APWU/USPS-T2-58, APWU/USPS-1-5, APMU-T1-3-5, DBP/USPS-60-61, DBP/USPS-75, DFC/USPS-7, DFC-USPS-11, OCA/USPS-T1-13, OCA/USPS-T1-21, OCA/USPS-34-35, and PB/USPS-T1-6. The documents and plans requested by APWU will also be filed on or before June 5, 2006.
