MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE
OF THE FILING OF ITS RESPONSE TO QUESTION 14
OF PRESIDING OFFICER'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the filing of its response to Question 14 of Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2, issued on April 27, 2006. The response was due to have been filed by May 11th. It is 32 calendar days late. Various factors contributed to the delay, most significantly of which was the disruption of the consultative process necessary for the completion and review of the response to this Question caused by the preparation and filing of Docket No. R2006-1, and the subsequent juggling of responsibilities arising from multiple Commission dockets among persons whose input was necessary to the response. The Postal Service regrets the delay.
