PAJUNAS (USPS-T-45) TO INTERROGATORY OF DOUGLAS F. CARLSON
(DFC/USPS-T45-5) [ERRATA] (June 26, 2006)

The Postal Service hereby gives notice that today it is filing a revised response of United States Postal Service witness Anthony M. Pajunas (USPS-T-45) to Interrogatory of Douglas F. Carlson, DFC/USPS-T45-5. In the original response, filed on June 23, 2006, witness Pajunas stated that "[m]ail that travels on the FedEx network can . . . transfer through Indianapolis, Newark, Alliance (Dallas), or Memphis." The revised response adds the words "hubs, such as" before Indianapolis, to clarify that witness Pajunas is not purporting to give an exhaustive list of FedEx facilities through which mail can transfer. No other changes have been made. The attached revised response should be substituted for the original response filed on June 23, 2006.
