PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING CANCELLING
TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED HEARING

(September 26, 2006)

Presiding Officer's Ruling C2004-2/7, issued August 18, 2006, established a schedule for the final procedural steps in this proceeding, including setting October 5 as the tentative hearing date for cross-examination of the surrebuttal testimony of Rick Borgers on behalf of DigiStamp, Inc. No participant filed timely notice that it intended to cross-examine Mr. Borgers.

Consistent with Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 7, as no participant seeks to cross-examine Mr. Borgers, the hearing tentatively scheduled for October 5 is cancelled. The balance of the procedural schedule in this proceeding remains unchanged. Initial briefs will be due October 6, and reply briefs will be due October 13, see Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 7, Appendix, fn. 2.

Notwithstanding the currently pending Motion of the United States Postal Service to Strike Portions of the Surrebuttal Testimony of DigiStamp Witness Borgers, filed September 20, 2006, DigiStamp should provide corrected copies of its complete surrebuttal testimony for incorporation into the record as provided in Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 7, Appendix, fn. 3.

RULING

The hearing tentatively scheduled for October 5, 2006, is cancelled.
