MOTION OF OFFICE OF THE CONSUMER ADVOCATE  
TO REOPEN THE RECORD TO RECEIVE LATE-FILED WRITTEN  
CROSS-EXAMINATION OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
(October 20, 2006)

The Office of the Consumer Advocate moves to reopen the record solely for the purpose of receiving into evidence a late-filed institutional response of the Postal Service.

The record in this proceeding was closed by the Presiding Officer's Ruling No. N2006-1/43 on October 16, 2006. The Postal Service filed late an institutional response on October 18, 2006, to interrogatory OCA/USPS-63, dated August 22, 2006. The response contains information material to the issues in this proceeding and no party will be unduly prejudiced by reopening the record to receive this material.

Concurrently with this motion, OCA is filing a designation of OCA/USPS-63 pursuant to Rule 30(e)(2) of the Commission's rules.
