PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
CORRECTING THE TRANSCRIPT

(Issued November 13, 2006)

In the process of reviewing the record in this proceeding, the Commission has determined that certain pages were omitted inadvertently from the transcript of the August 15, 2006 hearing. Among the interrogatory responses designated as written cross-examination by the Office of the Consumer Advocate was OCA/USPS-RT1-11.¹ The response to this interrogatory includes a four-page attachment consisting of a notice from the *Federal Register*.² Apparently, the attachment was not included in the packet submitted to the witness at the August 15, 2006 hearing. Thus, the attachment was not transcribed, although the response to OCA/USPS-RT1-11 was. See Tr. 1/120.

This Ruling rectifies that oversight. The attachment to OCA/USPS-RT1-11 will be received into evidence and will be transcribed as an addendum to Volume 1 of the transcript to be numbered consecutively as pages 120A through 120D.
