**JOINT MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE AND  
WASHINGTON MUTUAL BANK FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEFS**  
(November 17, 2006)

Co-proponents United States Postal Service and Washington Mutual Bank (WMB) hereby move for an extension of time to file initial briefs in Docket No. MC2006-3, currently scheduled to be filed on November 20, 2006. See PO Ruling No. MC2006-3/9.

At the hearing on November 9, 2006, the OCA requested that the Postal Service or WMB provide WMB's fiscal year 2006 volumes for First-Class Mail marketing and customer volumes and Standard Mail volumes. (Tr. 4/398). The Postal Service stated that it would supply that data if such data were available for those breakdowns. Id. Please see Status Report on Response of the United States Postal Service to the Question Raised by the OCA at the Hearing on November 9, 2006, filed concurrently with this motion.

The Postal Service estimates that it will be able to file the requested data with the Commission during the week of November 27, 2006. However, the co-proponents, intervenors, and the OCA will need additional time to review this data before filing the initial briefs. Therefore, the co-proponents respectfully

request that the deadline for filing the briefs be extended to one week after the filing of WMB's FY06 volume data.
