The United States Postal Service hereby moves that its response to interrogatories OCA-USPS-T1-32-33 be accepted out of time. The Postal Service's response to those interrogatories was due on March 21, 2007. The delay was caused by a variety of factors, including the need to coordinate the response among several functional organizations. Given the nature of the inquiry and the current posture of the case, the Postal Service does not believe any party has been prejudiced by the delay of two days. The Postal Service's response to OCA/USPS-T1-31 will be forthcoming.
