**MOTION OF LIFE LINE SCREENING TO WITHDRAW MOTIONS FOR  
PROTECTIVE CONDITIONS  
(APWU/LLS-T1-1-4, 6, and 7)**

**(October 12, 2007)**

On October 5, 2007, Life Line Screening filed a motion to establish protective conditions regarding its responses to interrogatories from the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (“APWU”). *See* Motion of Life Line Screening for Protective Order Regarding Response of Witness Greenberg to Interrogatories of the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (APWU/LLS-T1-4, 6, and 7). On October 11, 2007, the APWU filed a Response in Opposition to Life Line’s motion.

Without regard to the merits of the APWU’s position, and in the interests of moving these proceedings toward conclusion without further delay, Life Line has decided to file responses to the listed APWU interrogatories publicly. Life Line has determined that it can respond without revealing information that would place Life Line at a significant competitive disadvantage. Accordingly, Life Line moves to withdraw its motion to file these responses under seal.
