**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE NOTICE OF ERRATA TO
CONFIDENTIAL WORKPAPER I OF WITNESS LESLIE SCHENK (USPS-T-3)**
(April 26, 1999)

The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is filing errata (in hard-copy and diskette form) to Confidential Workpaper I, which supports the direct testimony of Docket No. MC99-2 witness Leslie Schenk (USPS-T-3).

As indicated in the April 22, 1999, status report concerning negotiations in Docket No. MC99-1, some minor errata in the confidential workpaper were identified during the April 20, 1999, technical conference. The revisions to that workpaper which are being filed today correct those errors.

The aforementioned status report also indicated that the confidential workpaper errata were likely to have minor downstream ripple effects in some of the interrogatory responses filed by Docket No. MC99-1 witness James Kiefer (USPS-T-1), as well as the direct testimony of Docket No. MC99-2 witnesses Schenk (USPS-T-3) and Kiefer (USPS-T-4), but also made clear that the corrections would not affect the permanent fees proposed by witness Kiefer in Docket No. MC99-2. The relative insignificance of the errata can be confirmed by examination of the corrections to the interrogatory responses and the Docket No. MC99-2 testimonies which also are being filed today.

Accompanying the hard copy of the revised confidential workpaper is a list of the four numerical changes on revised pages 5 and 6 of the narrative portion of that workpaper. The numerical changes on Tables 3 and 5 through 7 of the confidential workpaper are indicated by shading the new numbers on the revised hard copy pages of those tables and in the revised electronic version.

The revised hard copy pages of the workpaper being filed *in camera* today supersede the pages originally filed *in camera* with the Commission on March 10, 1999. The revised diskette version of the workpaper being filed *in camera* today replaces the diskette originally filed *in camera* on April 8, 1999.

Parties are also hereby notified that the Postal Service considers the workpaper revisions to be subject to the protective conditions specified by the Presiding Officer in Ruling Nos. MC99-1/1 and MC99-2/1 (March 29, 1999).


