INTERROGATORY COS/USPS-45

Please confirm that the Postal Service is unwilling to enter into an NSA similar to the Bank of America NSA with any mailer, regardless of the mailer's read/accept rate. The phrase "an NSA similar to the Bank of America NSA" refers to a three-year NSA that in general (1) provides the mailer discounts based on the difference between (a) the mailer's actual observed read/accept rates, return rates, and forwarding rates and (b) corresponding rates set as baselines in the NSA; and (2) requires the mailer to commit to implementation of IMB, OneCode ACS, CONFIRM, Seamless Acceptance, FAST and eDropship, barcoding of Courtesy and Business Reply Mail and Qualified Business Reply Mail, and waiver of physical return of certain First-Class Mail and Standard Mail letters, as described on pages 2-3 of the Decision of the Governors in MC2007-1 (December 17, 2007).
