**OBJECTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
TO DOCUMENT REQUESTS OF CAPITAL ONE SERVICES, INC.
(COS/USPS-DR-23-38)
(April 30, 2009)**

In accordance with Rules 25 and 27 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the United States Postal Service hereby objects to Document Requests COS/USPS-DR-23 through 38. The Postal Service objects to these document requests for the primary reason that they are moot in light of the Commission's Order No. 208 on Capital One Motion to Compel and Extension of Deadlines Certified to the Commission by Presiding Officer's Ruling No. C2008-3/38, issued April 29, 2009. With that Order, the Commission established a process for the review and production of Postal Service documents subject to Capital One's requests. The Postal Service understands Order No. 208 to encompass the documents requested in the instant requests, as well as others, to the extent such documents exist; this is particularly so given the apparent duplication of the subject matter to Capital One's Document Request COS/USPS-C2008-3/22 in many, if not all, of the instant requests. If this good-faith understanding of Order No. 208 is in error, then the Postal Service respectfully requests that the Commission permit it a reasonable extension of the instant deadline so that the Postal Service may present its specific objections.

Therefore, for the foregoing reasons, the Postal Service respectfully objects to
COS/USPS-DR-22.
