Nanci E. Langley Sworn In as Commissioner

Washington, DC – Postal Regulatory Commission Chairman Dan G. Blair today swore in Nanci E. Langley as a Commissioner of the Postal Regulatory Commission, following her official appointment by President George W. Bush last week.

Commissioner Langley was nominated by President Bush on February 26, 2008, and confirmed by the U.S. Senate on June 4, 2008, for a term extending through November 22, 2012. For the past fifteen months, she has served as the Commission's first Director of the Office of Public Affairs and Government Relations. In addition to her tenure on the Postal Regulatory Commission, Langley served in the office of U.S. Senator Daniel K. Akaka (D-HI) for 17 years. For nine years, she was his Deputy Staff Director on the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs' Subcommittee on Oversight of Government Management, the Federal Workforce and the District of Columbia. Senator Akaka served as the chairman and ranking member of the Senate Postal Subcommittee from 1999 to 2002, and was the acting ranking member during the Senate's postal reform hearings. For eight years, she was the communications director to the late U.S. Senator Spark M. Matsunaga (D-HI).

"Ensuring a fair balance between the flexibilities given to the Postal Service by the Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act, with the accountability and transparency provided by the Postal Regulatory Commission will be my goal, as a Commissioner. I have tremendous respect for my fellow Commissioners, who carry out their duties with great responsibility and bipartisanship. I look forward to sitting with them," said Langley.

Commissioner Langley, who resides in Falls Church, Virginia, with her husband, William Selander, earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Southern California. She was raised in Honolulu, Hawaii where she graduated from Punahou School.
