Chairman Kubayanda Testifies Before the Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

Washington, DC – Today Postal Regulatory Commission Chairman Michael Kubayanda testified before the United States Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs at a hearing titled “[Oversight of the United States Postal Service.](#)” Chairman Kubayanda testified that he hopes Postal Service leadership will be more transparent on plan changes moving forward.



Other witnesses in attendance and providing testimony included: Postmaster General and Chief Executive Officer Louis DeJoy, Chairman of the Board of Governors Roman Martinez, IV, and Postal Service Inspector General Tammy Hull.

The Commission is comprised of five presidentially-appointed and Senate-confirmed commissioners, each serving terms of six years. The President designates the chairman. In addition to Chairman Michael Kubayanda, the other commissioners are Vice Chairman Thomas Day, and Commissioners Ann Fisher, Ashley Poling, and Robert Taub.
